CT ABDOMEN PELVIS W CONTRAST 4/30/2018 4:44 PM CLINICAL INFORMATION: FAILURE TO THRIVE; bilateral lower quadrant pain on exam. Reports lumbar back pain. COMPARISON: CT 03/01/2018. TECHNIQUE: Contrast enhanced CT images were obtained of the abdomen and pelvis. 100 cc of Omnipaque 300 was administered. No oral contrast material was administered. Coronal and sagittal multiplanar reformats were created. In order to reduce the radiation dose administered to the patient, this CT scanner uses protocols incorporating automated exposure control and adjustment of the mA and/or kV according to patient size. TOTAL DLP (mGy*cm): 959.4. CTDI (mGy): 0.08; 17.68. FINDINGS: Lower chest: Bilateral basal atelectatic changes are noted. Liver: Unremarkable. Gallbladder and biliary tree: Pneumobilia is again noted, unchanged. The gallbladder is surgically absent. No intra- or extrahepatic biliary ductal dilation. Spleen, pancreas, and adrenals: Prior Whipple procedure changes are again noted. Remainder of the pancreas is mildly atrophic. Kidneys and ureters: Multiple bilateral renal cysts identified, the largest within the left kidney measuring up to 55 mm. There is mild/moderate distention of the left renal pelvis with more normalized appearance of the left ureter which may represent changes of chronic UPJ obstruction versus prominent extrarenal pelvis. Bladder: Foley catheter within a partially decompressed bladder with air foci are noted. Reproductive organs: TURP defect within the prostate gland is again noted. Gastrointestinal tract: Moderate colonic fecal loading is present. The appendix is normal in caliber. No bowel obstruction. Gastrojejunal anastomosis is again noted. Prominent gastric distention filled with fluid/debris is again noted. Lymph nodes: Unremarkable. Peritoneum: Mild stranding within the left anterior mesentery along with redemonstration of nodular opacity measures up to 9 mm, unchanged (2-48). Vessels: Moderate calcific atherosclerosis of the abdominal aorta with mural thrombi are noted Bones: Right hip arthroplasty is unchanged. Diffuse osteopenia. Moderate lumbar spondylosis. Soft tissues: Unremarkable. IMPRESSION - Moderate colonic fecal loading is present. The appendix is normal in caliber. No bowel obstruction. Prominent gastric distention filled with fluid/debris is again noted. Mild stranding within the left anterior mesentery along with redemonstration of nodular opacity measures up to 9 mm, unchanged.
